## Patient's Chief Complaint:

Patient indicated that he has been feeling depressed since moving in December 2013. Patient is concerned that, despite all of his hard work, he has been **unable to produce fruit**.

## Patient's History:

Prior to moving to the Sahara desert in 2013, the patient was able to produce fruit on a consistent basis. Patient indicated that he missed living with all of his friends in the peach orchard back home in Georgia. Patient was relocated to a remote region in Northern Africa in the Sahara desert for an extended "time-out" per the orchard owner's decision. Patient stated that his former owner was "a really, really mean guy." When the patient was asked why he had a time-out, he stated: "The owner doesn't like my bee impressions and said I constantly annoy all the other peaches in the orchard."

Patient stated that he believed his depression was due in part to his inability to cope with the silence in the desert as he needs to have background noise in order to sleep soundly.

## Referrals/Tests/Treatments:

Physical examination shows **no abnormality** with patient's body. All of the flower structures appear to be in working order. The patient's leaves, stem, and roots are all in **optimum health**. The patient is receiving adequate levels of sunlight, food, water, and nutrients.

Psychiatric evaluation shows that the patient is moderately depressed due to isolation from friends and family.
